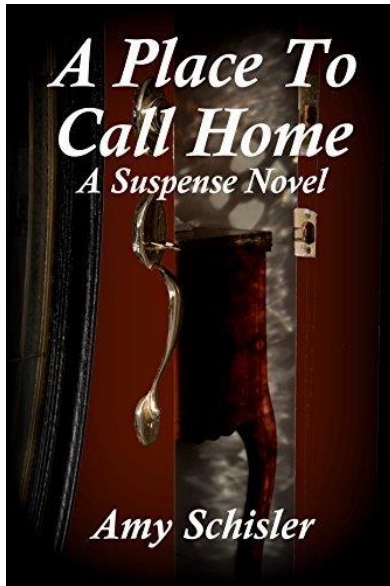


A Place to Call Home Discussion Questions
